Cresson was pleased to participate in the Great Kindness Challenge by engaging in school wide activities that promote kindness and community among children and adults. Students participated in a variety of activities including: writing thank you letters to community members, planting "Gardens of Kindness" in the school's planter boxes and listening to our guest readers read stories about kindness. Students were also given the opportunity to participate in "Kindness Bingo", which required them to complete kindness activities in order to fill up their card and earn a prize. Both students and staff enjoyed taking part in these opportunities to express and receive kindness.



Kindness Week was kicked off with a special event called Lunch with a Loved One. We invited families to join their children at school for lunch. Students and their visitors were invited to sit together and share a meal in the cafeteria or our outside picnic tables. Many of our parents brought lunch for their children, while some chose to share the school bag lunch. Teachers and other staff joined families and students to either share the meal or simply spend time together. More than 200 adult visitors attended this special event, in addition to some younger siblings. It meant so much to the children to have a loved one, or several, come to school for nothing more than a simple meal together.



There was a study in England in which parents were asked to name the person that their child would most enjoy to have dinner with. Most of the parents named a famous person, a sports celebrity, movie star, or singer – that their child admired as the person of choice. The children were then asked the same question and their response was videotaped. The video was shown to the parents, who were shocked to discover that the person(s) their child most wanted to have dinner with was them. I'm sure that if we conducted a similar study with our students, the result would be the same. So thank you, parents, for joining us for Lunch with a Loved One and allowing your children to share a meal with the people they most want to spend time with.
