Cresson's Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) Program

Cresson Elementary is proud to be the home of one of the few programs serving deaf students in the local area. For students and families in preschool through fifth grade, we offer a Total Communication program, which includes American Sign Language (ASL) and speech therapy. In addition to academic instruction, our DHH program empowers students to become self-advocates who are aware of their needs and capabilities. We teach them how to access resources such as sign interpreters, as well as how to engage and interact with their hearing peers.



Cresson's DHH program has been part of Little Lake City School District for more than 30 years, and we have encouraged awareness of deaf culture, the deaf community, and deaf education. Our hearing students and staff are exposed to presentations about deaf culture and our deaf friends, and have been taught some basic Sign Language in order to facilitate communication. At various times, we have



offered after-school classes in ASL to students, parents, and district staff. In addition, each year at Back-to-School Night and Open House, our DHH team plans and hosts events in which they invite deaf adults and their family members to share their experiences with our students and families. This interaction allows our students and their parents to talk about the

challenges and, more importantly, to empower them with the possibilities that exist for a bright and productive future for our DHH students.

El programa DHH de Cresson ha sido parte del distrito de Little Lake por más de 30 años y hemos alentado conciencia para la comunidad sorda y su educación. Nuestros alumnos y personal son expuestos a presentaciones que hablan sobre la cultura y se les ha enseñado algunas señas básicas que pueden facilitar la comunicación. En varias ocasiones hemos proporcionado clases de ASL después de escuela para padres, estudiantes y personal del distrito. Además, en la noche de regreso



a clases y *Open House*, nuestro equipo DHH planea un evento en donde se les invita a adultos sordos y familias para que puedan compartir sus experiencias con nuestros estudiantes y familias. Esta interacción ayuda a que alumnos y padres puedan compartir sus retos y lo que es aún más importante para empoderarlos
