EARLY DISMISSAL (1:30 pm) the first week of school - Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, Aug. 16, 17, and 18



ARRIVING ON CAMPUS/STUDENT DROP OFF

Student safety is our top priority. Please be mindful when dropping off your child/children. We ask for your patience and courtesy. ONLY those students who will be eating breakfast should arrive at 7:40 am and enter through the MPR/cafeteria. Students should not be dropped off before 7:40 am since there is no supervision until 7:40 am.

All students not having breakfast will enter at 8:00 am. Our back gate (Gate #1) along Alburtis will also open at 8:00 am for 3rd-5th grade students. Teacher Tammy and Mrs. James' class will enter through Gate #2. Please see the map attached below. Parents may park on the street and walk their child to the gate or may drop off curbside (valet-style). Please pull up in the driveway or curb as far as possible to avoid traffic and please avoid exiting your vehicle. This is a drive-through lane only. For your child's safety, please do not drop off on the inner lane of the drive-through or double park.

CLOSED CAMPUS

Please remember that student safety is our top priority. With this in mind, I ask that you remember that we are a closed campus at all times - before, during, and after school. This means that students are to be dropped off and picked up at the gates. Our front office will remain locked, but we will have our front office staff available to assist you.



Please make it a priority to have your child arrive at school on time each and every day. Beginning on Monday, August 21st, dismissal for TK-3rd will be at 2:30 pm and 3:10 pm for students in 4th-5th. All students are dismissed at 1:30 pm every Wednesday.

PLEASE NO LUNCH DROP OFF

Please ensure your child takes their lunch to school with them each morning. *Lunches should only be dropped off if it is an emergency*. No fast food please. All students may receive a school lunch for free even if they bring lunch from home.

CELL PHONES AND SMART WATCHES

Students <u>may not</u> bring cell phones or smart watches to school. If a student needs to call home, they must call from the front office. If a phone or smart watch is confiscated, the parent or guardian may pick it up on Friday only after school.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Although students do not wear uniforms, all students are expected to follow an appropriate dress code. We ask parents/guardians to pay special attention to clothing worn especially during the warmer months and ensure students are not wearing short shorts or inappropriate attire. Please see the Dress Code Policy attached to your child's registration. A signed copy acknowledging your review of the school's policy must be returned by Friday, August, 18, 2023.

Dress Code Policy

All students are expected to follow the dress code as defined:

- <u>Blouses/Shirts</u> Bare midriffs (short blouses exposing stomach), see-through blouses, oversized shirts, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts **are not permitted**.
- <u>Pants/shorts</u> Baggy shorts or pants are not permitted. Pants or shorts with rips above the knee are not permitted. Shorts may not be tight or too short. Cut-off shorts that are below the knee with high socks **are not permitted.**
- <u>Shoes and socks</u> Closed-toed shoes and socks are to be worn at all times (ex: tennis shoes). Sandals, crocs, or high-heeled shoes **are not permitted.**
- <u>Hats, hoodies, and beanies</u> are not permitted. Hats and beanies may only be worn on specially designated days such as Spirit Days or outdoor field trips.
- All attire must be free of inappropriate wording, violent or graphic images (including animation characters/emojis portraying violence or weapons such as guns or knives or reference to drugs). Gang or gangster reference on clothing or hats is **not permitted**.
- Earrings may be worn only if they do not dangle.
- Make-up may not be worn.

Consequences for not following Dress Code Policy

Students who are dressed inappropriately may be sent to the office. Parents will be called to bring appropriate attire for the student. Please use your own discretion about anything not listed above.
