Get Ready for the New School Year!

Although students are not required to wear a uniform, all students are required to follow the appropriate dress code policy. Please review the dress code policy with your children.

Mandatory Dress Code Policy

- Pants cannot be more than one size larger than student's original size
- "Baggy" style pants or oversized, sagging clothes are not acceptable
- No sheer (see through) clothing
- No blouses with "spaghetti" straps
- No articles of clothing considered inappropriate by the staff. This includes T-shirts with inappropriate wording or images, gang or gangster reference
- No dangling earrings and chains.
- Shoes must be closed, no sandals
- Socks must be worn with shoes

Consequences for not following Dress Code Policy

Violation – Parents called to bring appropriate clothing for student. All violations will be referred to the principal.
