

Dress Code Policy 2023-2024

Although students are not required to wear a uniform, all students are required to follow the appropriate dress code policy. Please review the dress code policy with your children. A copy will be sent home with your child the first week of school and will be required to be signed and returned.

Dress Code Policy

Student Signature

All students are expected to follow the dress code as defined:

- **Blouses/Shirts** Bare midriffs (short blouses exposing stomach), see-through blouses, oversized shirts, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts are **not allowed**.
- **Pants/shorts** Baggy shorts or pants are **not allowed**. Shorts may not be tight or too short. Cut-off shorts that are below the knee with high socks are **not allowed**.
- Shoes and socks Closed toed shoes and socks are to be worn <u>at all times</u> (ex: tennis shoes). Sandals, crocs, or high-heeled shoes are **not allowed.**
- Hats may only be worn while outdoors and <u>may not be worn indoors</u> at any time. Hats must be worn forward facing only.
- All attire <u>must</u> be free of inappropriate wording, violent or graphic images (including animation characters/emojis portraying violence or weapons such as guns or knives). Gang or gangster reference on clothing or hats is <u>not allowed.</u>
- Earrings may be worn only if they do not dangle.
- Make-up is not appropriate for any student.
